- 3. Elected officials declare **Local Emergency** per assessments above. (Use Declaration of State of Emergency and attach)

**#3 - ALERT GENERAL POPULATION AND EVACUATE AS NEEDED**

(For example: siren, public address system, Door-to-door, etc.)

- Method of alert: Door-to-door, Sirens, Radio Station
- Evacuation route: VT Rte. 26 as main route & VT Rte. 102 & NH Rte. 3 as appropriate
